Conditions of Entry & Sale

- 1.0 **GENERAL:** In signing and submitting this entry form the artist enters into a Contract with the **Rotary Club of Camberwell Inc.** [hereinafter referred to as 'the Club'] and agrees to comply with all of the following Conditions, and to hold the Club harmless in the event of any loss or damage whatsoever to the entered works, or the late receipt by the Club of this entry form or of the entered works, and to indemnify the Club in the event of any incorrect description, genuineness or authenticity of, or any fault or defect in, any work submitted. Handling fees are compulsory and are not refundable.
- 1.1 The Artist agrees to enter a maximum of six (6) works and warrants that they are his or her original uncopied work. All works must be entered on one [1] signed entry form [a photocopy or electronic data entry is acceptable]. If a person other than the Artist signs the entry form, a written statement must accompany it and an authority signed by the Artist acknowledging such entry of the work and that such person is so authorised.
- 1.2 The Artist appoints the Club as his or her agent for all purposes associated with exhibition and sale and agrees that all works will be for sale, except that this Condition may be waived by the Club in the case of works submitted by a Guest Artist, Celebrity Artist, or Invited Artist.
- 1.3 The Artist grants a licence to the Club to reproduce any work submitted for the purpose of publicity, promoting the exhibition, education, preparing a catalogue and sale of the paintings.
- 1.4 All judges' decisions will be final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
- 1.5 The Club reserves the right to exhibit such works as the Club and its judges may select to be on view from **April 23rd to May 2nd 2009** [inclusive]. An entry may not necessarily be displayed. The Club reserves the right, at any stage of the Exhibition, to hang or withdraw any work not selected for display at the opening of the sale/exhibition.
- 1.6 Note: The \$22.00 handling fee [includes GST] per painting is not refundable even if the work is not received by the Club by **April 18th 2009** or is not selected for hanging.
- 2.0 **ENTRIES:** Works submitted by a Celebrity Artist, Guest Artist or Invited Artist will not be eligible for competition. The Club reserves the right to invite artists to submit additional works, such works will be for exhibition and sale only.
- 2.1 **Section 'B'** of the entry form must be retained by the entrant and attached to the back top left corner of each work [when viewed from the rear], prior to delivery.
- 2.2 **FRAMING:** Stretched canvas is considered framed and must have rigid and adequate cross members. Each work must be fitted with substantial hanging wire or heavy-duty cord and 'flush D hangers.' [hangers which protrude, e.g. 'eye hooks' and which can damage other works when stored are not acceptable.]
The apex of the hanging wire or cord should be approximately 75 mm. below the top of the frame.
- 2.3 **SIZE OF PAINTING** No work submitted may have a length of any side of the painting that exceeds 1.40 metres including framing. All measurements are to be taken over the frame.
- 3.0 **AWARDS:** All major award winners are acquisitive. Winners of an award are not eligible for consideration for additional awards. The Club reserves the right to put up for sale any award painting should the sponsor not wish to accept the painting. Encouragement awards are not acquisitive.
- 3.1 The Club reserves the right not to make an award in any category, if in the opinion of the Judging Panel, works submitted do not satisfy the relevant award standard.
- 3.2 All awards shall be conferred by the Club exercising its sole discretion.
- 4.0 **NON-ACCEPTABLE WORK:** Works of beaten metal, photographs, digitally enhanced artwork, 'worked' prints, prints including linocuts, monoprints, stencils, etc., etchings, pokerwork, pyrography, textile art works, bark arrangements, plaster relief work, unprotected tempera, collages, triptychs and diptychs or wet paintings, are not acceptable. This condition applies to all artists.
- 5.0 **COMMISSION:** The Club shall be entitled to offer any entry for sale to the public at the price endorsed on the entry form and in the event of the sale being effected retain twenty-seven and half per centum [27.5%] of such price as a selling commission. The commission includes a GST component payable by all entrants.
- 6.0 **INSURANCE:** The Club will exercise all reasonable care in handling the works submitted, but will not be responsible for the loss of or any damage to any works while in the custody of the Club or the Club's agents. **Artists are responsible for insuring their works against loss or damage when in custody of the Club or in transit.**
- 7.0 **RECEIPT:** Personal delivery of paintings will be received at the Camberwell Centre between **10am and 6pm Friday, 17th April, & Saturday, 18th April 2009. Works will not be accepted or considered if received after 18th April nor will any fees be refunded.**
- 8.0 **COLLECTION:** Unsold paintings must be collected by artists or their agents or proxies from the Camberwell Centre between **8.30am & 6.00pm, Sunday, May 3rd 2009**, unless forwarding instructions are given on the entry form. Note that an additional late handling fee of \$22.00 per painting will be incurred if not collected by 6pm, **Sunday May 3rd.**
Paintings not selected for hanging may be collected by artists during the last 2 days of the Show by prior arrangement with the Art Show Chairman.
- 9.0 **COUNTRY, INTERSTATE & OVERSEAS ENTRIES:** Entries must be delivered free of all charges. *No payments whatsoever will be made by the Club for freight or other charges incurred in delivery or return of entries. Separate arrangements apply to Courier deliveries [See Newsletter for details]*
- 10.0 **UNCOLLECTED WORKS:** If an Artist fails to remove his or her work[s] from the designated address as provided in the Entry Form and Conditions, the Club, after sending by registered post to the Artist at his or her last-known address, one month's notice of the Club's intention to sell or otherwise dispose of such work, or, in the event of no such address of the Artist being known to the Club, then one month after advertising notice of such intention in a newspaper, may sell such work or works and after deducting from such proceeds the cost of and incidental to the sale hold the balance for the Artist **provided** however that in the event of such work or works being in the opinion of the Club unsaleable then the Club may, in lieu of selling the same, destroy or otherwise

dispose of them in such a manner as the Club may deem fit and thereafter the Club shall be under no liability whatsoever to the Artist in respect to any work so destroyed or disposed of. Any notice sent by post as aforesaid shall be deemed to have been received by the Artist on the date when it would have been delivered in the ordinary course of post.

- 11.0 **GOODS & SERVICES TAX 'GST'** has been applied to charges: Painting Handling Fee & Sales Commission and other areas, which reflect the GST component. Artists should complete the GST Section on the reverse side of the entry form. Select one of the four categories and provide relevant information. Artists are liable for all and any GST on painting sales [where applicable] and are personally responsible for all and any GST payments and compliance required by the GST or related law and the Australian Tax Office [ATO]. Your signature is needed to acknowledge that this information is correct [see Entry Form 'A']. Awards will include GST where applicable. Awards of cash prizes to artists holding an ABN and GST registrations will include any requisite GST amount in addition to the published competition prize amount. Non-cash awards are GST inclusive values unless otherwise indicated.

Artists agree to pay the GST amount of all and any charges in connection with entry and competition fees; and GST applicable in any other charges arranged for the handling or return of paintings or otherwise in connection with the artist's participation in the 2009 Herald Sun-Camberwell Rotary Art Show. The GST factors outlined in the Conditions of Entry and Sale, Entry Form and relevant documents are based on the Club's understanding of the application of the relevant law as at 1/12/2006. The position is subject to change for any variations in the law or official policy, which may subsequently occur.
